- **Dice-based questions** (Q.95–96) tested 3D visualization & face positioning.
- Alphabetical patterns and analogies (Q.83, Q.97–98) appeared consistently good focus area for revision.
- Real-life analogies (Q.99-100) (e.g., "Body: Physiology :: Heart: ?") test static general knowledge with logic.
- No blood relation or direction sense questions in 2024.
- Visual pattern reasoning (Q.90, 94) keeps its usual significance.



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
